Battle of Britain – The Turning Point

- Journey back to 1940 and retell the story of the Battle of Britain in a mass singing event alongside hundreds of other school children.
- See, hear, and sing alongside a professional orchestra, conductor, and soloists.
- Learn the songs in school then join in from your seats during the performance.
- Narrated by a young Spitfire pilot and his sister, a secret RADAR operator, the event teaches children about the Battle of Britain including its effect on refugee children.
- Dress up on concert day to add to the theatrical experience.

Information for Schools:

- Battle of Britain – The Turning Point, will take place on **Monday 4 March 2024** at Cadogan Hall, SW1X 9DQ (schools must arrange their own travel). The orchestra will be the [Royal Philharmonic Orchestra](#) and the performance will be conducted by [Benjamin Pope](#).
- The event is suitable for children aged 7 – 11 (KS2). Schools can bring as many or as few students as they like, some bring choirs, classes, or whole year groups. Performances start at 11.30am or 1.45pm and last 1 hour.
- Teaching materials will be sent to your school to help the children learn the songs. The music is suitable for all abilities and great fun to learn, it can be built into the music or history curriculum or taught at another time. Resources we provide include music and lyrics sheets, recordings of the songs and videos with lyrics.
- Tickets are £5 for children and accompanying adults. Tickets for Pupil Premium students are free of charge. If you're your school requires further financial support, please email us regarding our Hardship Fund.
- The Classical Road Show had been organizing concerts for primary school children for more than 30 years. Battle of Britain was written especially for performance by professional orchestra, narrators and massed children's voices by Richard Brown and was last performed in 2023.
